BRUINS HONORED NUMBERS



EDWARD W. SHORE - Defense

The only defenseman in NHL history to win four Hart Trophies as league MVP...An eight-time NHL All-Star, although he played for four seasons before All-Star teams were conceived in 1930-31...Won two Stanley Cups with the Bruins, in 1929 and 1939...Was among the first group of inductees into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1945.



LIONEL HITCHMAN - Defense

Was the first captain of the Bruins, wearing the 'C' from 1927-31...Was paired on defense with Eddie Shore for eight seasons and often played the entire 60 minutes of a game...Finished second in the Hart Trophy balloting as the NHL MVP in 1929-30...Was a member of the Bruins' first Stanley Cup championship team in 1929.



ROBERT G. ORR - Defense

Won 16 NHL trophies in his ten seasons in Boston, including three Hart Trophies as league MVP and two Ross Trophies as the only defenseman to ever win a scoring title...Won the Norris Trophy for eight straight seasons and two Conn Smythe Trophies as MVP of the playoffs in the 1970 and 1972 Cup-winning campaigns...A nine-time NHL All-Star...Was the first player in NHL history to record six consecutive 100-point seasons...Elected to the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1979.



AUBREY V. CLAPPER - Right Wing/Defense

Was the first player in the NHL to play for 20 seasons and served as Boston captain for 14 years...Played his first nine seasons as a right wing, earning two NHL All-Star berths at that position, and played his final 11 as a defenseman, with four additional All-Star appearances on the blueline...Played his final game on February 12, 1947 and was inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame immediately after that game...Is the only Bruin to play on three championship teams - 1929, 1939 and 1941.



PHILIP A. ESPOSITO - Center

Was the first player in NHL history to record 100 points in a season and scored 100+ points in six seasons...Won the Hart Trophy as NHL MVP twice and the Ross Trophy as the league's top scorer on five occasions...Named an NHL All-Star in eight of his nine Boston seasons...Led the NHL in goals for six straight years, including shattering the league scoring record with 76 goals in 1970-71...Won two Stanley Cups with Boston, in 1970 and 1972...Elected to the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1984.



BRUINS HONORED NUMBERS



CAMERON M. NEELY - Right Wing

Named an NHL All-Star on four occasions...Led the team in goals for seven of his ten seasons, including three 50-goal seasons, and holds the team record of goals by a wing with 55 in 1989-90...Won the Masterton Trophy for dedication in 1993-94 when he scored 50 goals in just 44 games after missing most of the previous two seasons with thigh, knee and hip injuries...Is the team's all-time playoff goal leader...Injuries forced his retirement in September, 1996...Elected into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2005.



JOHN P. BUCYK - Left Wing

Played 21 seasons in a Bruins uniform, held every team career offensive record for over 20 years, remains the team's all-time goal scorer and is second on the team's all-time scoring list...Served as team captain for five seasons and won two Stanley Cups with Boston, in 1970 and 1972...Won two Lady Byng Trophies as the league's most gentlemanly player and was twice an NHL All-Star...Elected into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1981.



MILTON C. SCHMIDT - Center

Is the only man in Bruins history to serve the club as player, captain, coach and General Manager...Won four Stanley Cups with the team, in 1939 and 1941 as a player and in 1970 and 1972 as GM...Was a four-time NHL All-Star, won the Hart Trophy as league MVP in 1951 and the Art Ross scoring title in 1940...Centered the famed "Kraut Line" which became the first line in NHL history to finish 1-2-3 in the league's scoring race (1939-40)...Missed three years of his career from 1942-1945 while serving in World War II with the Royal Canadian Air Force...Elected into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1961.



TERENCE J. O'REILLY - Right Wing

Epitomized the Bruins of his generation with his toughness combined with offense...One of four players to lead the team in scoring and penalty minutes in the same season...Served as the team captain from 1983-85...Still ranks eighth on the all-time team scoring list and is the club's all-time leader in penalty minutes...Also coached the team from 1986-89.



RAYMOND J. BOURQUE - Defense

Was the first non-goaltender in league history to win the Calder Trophy and be named a First Team All-Star in his rookie season...Won five Norris Trophies as the league's top defenseman and was named an NHL All-Star 18 times...Finished his career with the Bruins as the team's all-time leader in games, assists and points and is the NHL's all-time leading scorer among defensemen... Elected into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2004.
