BOSTON BRUINS PRE-SEASON GAME NOTES



2008 PRE-SEASON NOTES:

The Bruins currently have 27 players remaining on their training camp roster ... They began camp on Sept. 19 with 56 players ... 21 of those players were attending their first Boston camp.

Game One: Sept. 22: Boston 8 vs. Montreal 3 at Halifax, Nova Scotia ... Patrice Bergeron (1-3=4) and Marco Sturm (2-2=4) paced the Bruins in their first pre-season victory with four points each in the 8-3 win over Montreal ... Andrew Ference (1-2=3), Vladimir Sobotka (2-0=2) and Andrew Alberts, Phil Kessel and David Krejci (0-2=2 totals each) all had multiple-point efforts as well ... Manny Fernandez earned the win in net, allowing two goals in 40 minutes of play before yielding to Kevin Regan, who played 20 minutes with one goal against in the third period ... The Bruins outshot the Canadiens by a 42-19 margin ... The Bruins went 4 for 10 on the power play while going 8 for 9 on the penalty kill.

Game Two: Sept. 23: Boston 1 vs. NY Islanders 2/OT at Moncton, New Brunswick ... Dennis Wideman opened the scoring with the Bruins' lone goal of the game assisted by Matt Hunwick and Martins Karsums ... The teams ended regulation tied at 1-1 before New York's Trevor Smith settled the decision at 2:03 of overtime ... Tuukka Rask played the entire game in goal for Boston ... The Bruins were outshot by a 38-19 margin ... Boston went 0 for 6 on the power play while going 6 for 7 on the penalty kill.

Game Three: Sept. 25: Boston 3 vs. Detroit 4 at Halifax, Nova Scotia ... The Bruins and Red Wings traded goals through a 3-3 score before Detroit's Brad Stuart scored the game-winning tally mid-way through the third period ... Jeremy Reich, Martin St. Pierre and P.J. Axelsson scored the Boston goals, while St. Pierre added an assist and Martins Karsums had two assists for multiple-point nights ... Tim Thomas played the entire game in goal for Boston ... The Bruins were outshot by a 40-33 margin ... Boston went 1 for 2 on the power play while killing off each of their 2 times short.

Game Four: Sept. 26: Boston 2 vs. Detroit 1 at Detroit, Michigan ... The Bruins opened the scoring on P.J. Axelsson's third goal of the pre-season in the first period before Detroit's Darek Meech evened the score at the 2:40 mark of the third ... Michael Ryder answered with the third period game-winner with 14 minutes to play ... Tuukka Rask played his second full game of the pre-season in goal facing 25 shots ... The Bruins were outshot by a 25-19 margin ... All goals came at even strength with the Bruins going 0 for 3 on the power play while killing off all 5 of their times short.

Game Five: Sept. 27: Boston 3 vs. Washington 4 at Boston, Massachusetts ... After Washington opened the scoring, the Bruins took a 2-1 lead on goals by Andrew Ference and Blake Wheeler but the Capitals evened the score to end the first period in a 2-2 tie ... Washington took a 3-2 second period lead before Petteri Nokelainen scored early in the third period to knot the score again but the Capitals' Chris Bourque, son of Bruins legend Ray Bourque, scored the winner for Washington at 17:45 of the third period ... Tim Thomas played the entire game in goal for Boston ... The Bruins outshot the Capitals by a 31-21 margin ... Boston went 0 for 6 on the power play while killing off just 1 of their 3 times short.

Game Six: Oct. 1: Boston 1 vs. Montreal 3 at Montreal, Quebec ... Following a scoreless first period, the Canadiens struck for three power play goals including two 5-on-3 tallies to take a 3-0 lead into the third ... Zdeno Chara scored the lone goal for Boston in the third period, also on the power play ... Manny Fernandez played the entire game in net for Boston ... The Bruins outshot the Canadiens by a 34-28 margin ... Boston went 1 for 5 on the power play while the Canadiens tallied 3 power play goals in 6 opportunities.

2008 NEW YORK ISLANDERS PRE-SEASON GAME NOTES

OCTOBER 4, 4:00 PM AT BOSTON BRUINS IN BOSTON, MA

“FLASH” GORDON: The Islanders announced the hiring of Scott Gordon as the franchise’s 14th head coach on August 12, 2008. He is the reigning recipient of the 2008 Louis A.R. Pieri Memorial Award, presented to the American Hockey League’s Coach of the Year. In 2007-08, Gordon led the Providence Bruins to an AHL-best record of 55-18-3. Assistant Coaches John Chabot and Dan Lacroix return as do Mike Dunham and Sudsie Maharaj as the Goaltending Coach and Goaltending Consultant, respectively, to assist Gordon in his first season behind an NHL bench.

BAILEY’S BIG DAY: On his 19th birthday, the Islanders announced the signing of 2008 first round draft pick Josh Bailey to a three-year, entry-level contract. Bailey, a center, was chosen with the ninth overall selection in the draft this past June and has been attending Islanders training camp. “This is an exciting day for me and my family, especially when you sign your first NHL contract on your birthday,” said Bailey, who played the past three seasons in the OHL. “It’s certainly a day I’ll never forget. I still have a lot of work to do and I’m willing to do it.” The Oshawa, ON native tallied 29 goals and 67 assists to lead the Windsor Spitfires with 96 points last season.

THE INJURY BUG BITES: The New York Islanders have announced that defensemen Chris Campoli and Andy Sutton will miss several weeks, including the start of the regular season, with injuries. Campoli is recovering from a shoulder injury, while Sutton is recuperating from hand surgery.

WAIVER WIRE: The Islanders claimed defenseman Thomas Pock off waivers from the New York Rangers on September 29th. Pock has played in 59 career NHL games and has scored seven goals with seven assists for 14 points. In 195 AHL games, all with the Hartford Wolfpack, Pock has scored 23 goals along with 89 assists for 112 points and a plus/minus rating of +40. In 2005-06, Pock was named to the AHL’s Second All-Star Team.

“OVERSPEED”: In his first training camp, head coach Scott Gordon immediately implemented a new high-speed system of play referred to as “Overspeed”. “The essence of the style is to be constantly moving and getting the puck up the ice quickly,” said Jeff Tambellini. “It’s all about high speed with and without the puck and putting pressure on the opposition.” With a new system being put in place, Gordon is focusing on making sure everyone on the team is executing properly before heading into the regular season.

CAMP CUTS: The Islanders have reassigned 27 players from training camp. Eighteen players were returned to the organization's top affiliate in Bridgeport. These players included: LW Sean Bentivoglio, D Joe Callahan, D Jamie Fraser, LW Michael Haley, D Jordan Hart, C Tyler Haskins, C Rob Hennigar, RW Mike Iggulden, RW Jesse Joensuu, D Dustin Kohn, G Nathan Lawson, D Andrew MacDonald, C Tomas Marcinko, RW Vladimir Nikiforov, G Peter Mannino, LW Jason Pitton, RW Joel Rechlicz and C Ben Walter.

Nine players were also returned to their junior team: LW Justin DiBenedetto (Sarnia - OHL), LW Max Gratchev (Rimouski - QMJHL), D Travis Hamonic (Moose Jaw - WHL), D Mark Katic (Sarnia - OHL), D Simon Lacroix (Shawinigan - QMJHL), RW Matt Martin (Sarnia - OHL), D Jyri Niemi (Saskatoon - WHL), G Kevin Poulin (Victoriaville - QMJHL), D Jared Spurgeon (Spokane - WHL).

ISLANDERS IN MONCTON: The Islanders continued their trend of hosting training camp away from Long Island by holding 2008 camp in Moncton, New Brunswick. This was the second consecutive year the Islanders hosted camp in Moncton and third consecutive season the team hosted a pre-season game at Moncton Coliseum. Camp started on September 19th and ran through September 27th.

ROOKIE SHOWCASE: The Islanders rookies were perfect, posting a 3-0-0 record during camp. The rookies first squared off against the Boston Bruins' rookies, notching an 8-4 victory, led by a hat trick from Sean Bentivoglio. The young squad then took on two Canadian opponents, scoring 4-1 wins in games against the University of Moncton and the University of New Brunswick.

KEY FREE AGENT PICK-UPS: Through free agency, the Islanders were able to re-tool the team's roster and add organizational depth with 12 signings this offseason. The Islanders came to terms with defenseman Mark Streit on the opening day of free agency. Streit has played in 205 NHL games, tallying 25 goals and 84 assists for a total of 109 points in three seasons. The Orange and Blue also signed veteran center Doug Weight. Weight brings 1,131 games of NHL experience, including 265 goals and 704 assists for 969 points during his 16-year NHL career.

FRESH FACES: The Islanders added youth to their roster with the selection of thirteen new players via the 2008 NHL Entry Draft. Seven of those prospects were in Moncton for 2008 training camp. Headlining the list was center Josh Bailey, who was taken by the Islanders in the first round, ninth overall. Other selections that were in camp included: Travis Hamonic (2nd round-53rd overall), Jyri Niemi (3-72), Kevin Poulin (5-126), Matt Martin (5-148), Jared Spurgeon (6-156), and Justin DiBenedetto (6-175). Of those in camp, only Bailey remains with the team for Saturday afternoon's game.
